### ***Feed a Hungry Child***

Every day, almost 16,000 children die from hunger-related causes— one child every five seconds. Countries in which a large portion of the population battles hunger daily are usually poor and often lack the social safety nets we enjoy, such as soup kitchens, food stamps, and job training programs. Economically, the constant securing of food consumes valuable time and energy of poor people, allowing less time for work and earning income.

# **Project 10:42 (Matt 10:42)** **safe drinking water**

## **Water Chlorination Unit**

Every 6 seconds a child dies from complications and diseases related to unsafe drinking water. This unit uses a car battery and common table salt to chlorinate up to 55 gallons of water per minute. The process will destroy all bacterial contamination including that which causes typhoid. Each unit can meet the needs of a community of more than 2,000 people!

## **Water Filtration System**

The filtration system is an important compliment to the chlorination unit because it will filter out all parasitic contamination. When the two systems are used together, the water is 100% safe. The filtration system is made of readily available items such as plastic barrels and PVC!

The number of units needed is directly related to the volume of water used by a community.

### **Hydraulic Ram Pump**

Many communities in developing countries have to carry water in buckets from rivers or creeks. The hydraulic ram pump, made of PVC and other readily available items, utilizes laws of physics to pump water. It requires no electricity for operation. This pump can provide a continuous water supply for irrigating fields or for use with the water chlorination unit and filtration system.

Kenyan pastors also frequently walk several miles in order to be part of the Leadership institute.

The most common thing expressed after a trainings is, “We have never had this type of training before! Please, come back and teach the next level of the Institute.”

The majority of the people and indigenous pastors who [LEAMIS](#) works with make less than \$1 per day. They are committed to serve God with all they have.

## ***Laying Hens***

One hen can lay up to 200 eggs per year.

Eggs provide a valuable source of protein.

The diet for most children in developing nations consists primarily of starches.

Extra eggs can be sold, providing funds for health and educational needs.

Chickens provide excellent fertilizer for a family's garden plot.

Chickens eat bugs, helping with pest control.

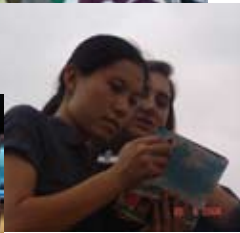
Some cottage industries (home businesses) provide utilitarian items such as candles and soap. Others provide food, as well as additional income, such as with milk or egg production.

The Nehemiah Project is designed to help participating churches, orphanages, or schools in a developing nation become self-sustainable. The project provides vocational and cottage industry training to encourage self-sustenance and a Biblical approach to earth stewardship.



The Nehemiah Project provides training in such things as: safe drinking water, sanitation systems, bio-fuel briquettes and bio-gas, aquaponics, animal husbandry, composting, and recycling.

LEAMIS encourages a “*pay it forward*” approach. Rather than paying back financially for the animals received, the first-born females are given to another person in the church, locally or in another community. In this way the blessing you provide is continually multiplied.

### ***Milk Goats***

Did you know?

Goats are the only milk source for half of the world's population. Goats require less water and land space than cows, and even children can easily care for them.

A goat can produce up to three quarts of milk per day.

Extra milk can be used to start a cottage industry. It can be sold as milk, or made into yogurt or cheese.

A healthy goat can produce two to three kids per year.

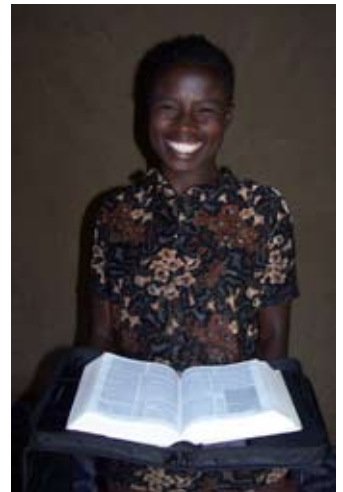
### ***Short-term Mission Trips***
